

Orangevale Rotary Benefit Auction Set for Sept 20

Since 2000, Rotarians of the Orangevale Club have put on a wonderful evening featuring great food, great silent and live auction items, and a chance to socialize with Orangevale neighbors and friends. The generously donated auction items support the Orangevale Rotary Charitable Fund, which provides funding for scholarships, support for Boy Scout and Girl Scout troops, and financing of community service projects for our area, such as the Casa Roble Softball Field of Dreams, renovations at Twin Lakes Food Bank, home painting for needy residents, and Partners in Education Grants for classroom teachers.

The celebrity guest auctioneer this year will be the new Fox40 TV Morning Show Host, Paul Robins. For over twenty years, Paul served as

morning guy on Y92, one of the most successful radio shows in the country.

The Orangevale Rotary Club is comprised of 53 dynamic community members. The club has been recognized as the Most Outstanding Club in the Sacramento region, winning this award six of the last nine years. The Sacramento District boasts 40 Rotary clubs with a current membership of more than 2,000 Rotarians. Rotary's motto "Service Above Self" is exemplified by the volunteer club members.

The Orangevale club works in the local community by performing smoke detector checks at mobile home parks, adopting local families in need during Thanksgiving and Christmas and supporting the Orangevale Library. Other projects include a new softball backstop at Oakview Elementary School, and Kids Korner Preschool facilities improvements, benefiting the children in Orangevale. In 2008, the club distributed over 500 illustrated hardcover dictionaries to every

3rd grade student in all of the five elementary Orangevale public schools.

The Orangevale Rotary Club also sponsors students to a leadership camp and awards college scholarships to students who achieve high academic standards and participate in community service. They sponsor a Rotary Interact Club at Casa Roble High School, as well as speech, photo and essay contests for our middle school and high school students.

Forms Assistance for Homeowners and Renters Rebate

Whether you own or rent your home, if you are over age 62 (or blind or disabled), you may qualify for this State of California tax rebate program. It's a once-a-year payment to qualified households with 2007 income of \$42,770 or less. Assistance to complete the form is being offered on Saturdays from 9 am to noon, continuing through October 11. Appointments can be scheduled by calling 808-5462.
